RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All exams will be in the hall, unless otherwise stated. Special provisions will be in various rooms around the school. Mrs Carson will notify those concerned.
2. Students must line up on the basketball courts at least 10mins prior to the start of exams. There is no extra time for anyone who arrives late..
3. **NO MOBILE PHONES- they are to be switched off and in bags. Anyone caught with a mobile phone (earphones etc),will have their paper cancelled and be given zero.**
4. Only clear pencil cases and approved calculators are allowed on desks - no other equipment unless required for the exam.
5. Students absent from an exam need to supply a medical certificate and sit the exam at a later date by the end of the term (to be negotiated with the Deputy).
No medical certificate will result in zero mark being awarded for the exam assessment task.
6. Normal exam rules apply- no talking, communication or any other form of distraction is allowed.
7. All students must stay for the entire duration of the exam.
8. There are no normal classes during the exam period. All year 11 are required to return to school on the 22/9/14 (Thursday, Week 10).

N.B. All Year 11 students are required to attend school Year 12 Graduation Assembly on Thursday 22/9 in full school uniform.
