#### **ATTENDANCE**

The Education Act (1990) requires parents/carers to ensure that children between the ages of six and seventeen attend school on each day that the school is open for instruction from 8:30am - 2:46pm. If your child is late to school, a note must be provided when they sign into school.

It is important that students attend school on time every day including roll call. Attending roll call sets them up for a positive start to the day, ensuring they hear the daily notices which include communication of any changes to the school day and upcoming extracurricular activities.

Starting on Monday 27 November any student who arrives late to school without a note from their parents/carers will be issued a detention at short break on that day. If they fail to attend the detention, they will be issued with three Deputy Principal Detentions.

Awards Day will be held on Wednesday 13 December. Students that are receiving awards on the day will receive an invitation during roll call within the next week.














#### YEAR 9 ARTWORK FOR ROTARY NOWRA
